- Plan rescues before work starts, not after someone is suspended
- Meet the legal duties that apply to working-at-height supervision

1. The anatomy of a fall: physics, injuries and case histories
2. Legal framework and the duty holder's responsibilities
3. The hierarchy of control for work at height
4. Access equipment: scaffolds, MEWPs, ladders and their limits
5. Personal fall protection: restraint, positioning and arrest
6. Equipment inspection: hands-on harness and lanyard checks
7. Suspension trauma and rescue planning
8. Permits, method statements and supervising the work
